
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## About the GO! Elementary Scope and Sequence:

Each year of the GO! Scope and Sequence takes kids on a chronological journey through the entire Bible with different stories and with a different emphasis. During the 2023-2024 ministry year, kids will see and experience both God's people and promises through the Big Bible Story, but there will be a special emphasis on God's power. From the first days of creation to the resurrection of Jesus and beyond, God has exhibited His omnipotence in

the protection, provision and pursuit of His people. Kids will discover that God still exhibits his power through the Holy Spirit by drawing us into a saving relationship with Him. There will be glimpses of God's salvation plan throughout the year, but there will be three-four lessons where that plan is communicated clearly and kids will have an opportunity to respond. Those lessons are denoted with \*\*\* next to the lesson title.

**Unit 10 THIS OR THAT**




