We need you, as a Check-In Host, to welcome parents and children at the Check-In counter with a big smile and help them find their way around. You win when families feel welcomed and cared for as soon as they walk through the doors.

ACCOUNTABILITY

Report to the Check-in Coach.

QUALIFICATIONS

- You love God.
- You care about kids and parents.
- You're committed to creating a first impression that is welcoming and friendly for kids and their families—especially first time guests.
- You completed and passed the serve form, background check, and interview process.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Be prepared.

- Wear your Children's Ministry shirt or nametag and a smile.
- Make sure iPads are ready to go, and printer labels full.

- Treat every family like they're the most important guest of the day.
- Make sure every family signs in at the Check-In station.
- Look for and engage with families who may be new, lost, or alone.
- Give visitors and first-time families the VIP treatment.
- Attend the appropriate training events and meetings whenever possible.



SMALL GROUP YOUTH ASSISTANT

THE WIN FOR THE SMALL GROUP LEADER

As a small group youth assistant, you invest in the lives of a few to encourage authentic faith. You win when children have meaningful interactions during group that deepen their faith in Jesus and influence godly character.

ACCOUNTABILITY

Report to the Small Group Leader and Coach

QUALIFICATIONS

- You love Jesus.
- You are in grade 5 or above.
- You have regular attendance at church/youth group.
- You display Christ like behavior.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Be present.

• Connect their faith to a community by showing up on time, wearing your name tag, and engaging the children in conversation.

Create a safe place

• Help the Small Group Leader by setting up the classroom and looking around to see how you can best help the kids. This could be helping a child with a craft or just helping a child feel welcome.

Make it personal.

• Inspire their faith by helping the children feel loved. Call them by name, give high fives, and be real with them.

- Come prepared by reading the lesson before class time so you are ready to help.
- Write the tasks you are helping with on the classroom white board.
- Attend the appropriate training events and meetings where possible.

Be present.

• Connect their faith to a community by showing up regularly, physically and mentally.

Create a safe place

• Clarify their faith as they grow by leading the group, respecting the process, and guarding the heart.

Partner with parents.

• Nurture an everyday faith by cueing the parent, honoring the parent, and reinforcing the family.

Make it personal.

• Inspire their faith by your example of living in community, setting priorities, and being real.

Move them out.

• Engage their faith in a bigger story of how they can be the church.

- Show up on time, 20 minutes prior to service.
- Come prepared by nurturing your own spiritual growth, reviewing the weekly small group lesson, and getting prayed up!
- Connect with your coach regularly and meet with them every six months.
- Attend the appropriate training events and meetings whenever possible.



SMALL GROUP LEADER COACH

THE WIN FOR THE SMALL GROUP LEADER COACH

We need you, as a coach to our Small Group Leaders, to both manage and shepherd the small group leaders in your care. You win when small group leaders feel known, trained, equipped, ready to lead, and celebrated so that they can do for their few what you do for them.

ACCOUNTABILITY

Report to the Elementary Pastors.

QUALIFICATIONS

- You love God.
- You're committed to consistently investing in and caring for your few over a period of time.
- · You completed and passed the serve form, background check, and interview process.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Make sure your small group leaders are known and celebrated.

- Connect with them regularly (email, call, text).
- Talk with them about what their weekend wins and struggles are and relay their stories to staff.
- Encourage them through regular and random notes, emails, and compliments to let them know you notice the great things they do.
- Meet one-on-one with them at least once every six months.
- Be aware of major events and needs in their personal lives.

Make sure your small group leaders are trained, equipped, & ready to lead.

- Ensure they have their weekly small group lesson, they are ready to receive their small group kids by being on time, and they are fully equipped.
- Do something every month to cue, train, and equip them.
- Communicate with and encourage them to attend small group leader training events and other important ministry events.
- Attend the appropriate training events and meetings whenever possible so that you are ready to train and meet with the leaders you lead.

- Commit to a regular schedule.
- Communicate with the Worship Team Leader Coach in advance if you plan to miss a week.

- Show up on time.
- Deliver energetic worship that engages kids.
- Attend the appropriate training events and meetings whenever possible.
