What is Baptism?

Baptism shows others you have accepted Jesus as the leader of your life.

Baptism shows
others we believe Jesus
died and lives again!

Often, we tell the story of how we came to know Jesus and what he means to us at the Baptism. This is called a “testimony”.

For you were
buried with Christ when you
were baptized.
And with him you were raised
to new life because you trusted
the mighty power of God, who
raised Christ from the dead.

Colossians 2:12

Why should we be Baptized?

God told us to! The Bible tells us that after we decide to follow Jesus we should become baptized.

Baptism shows others we have made the decision to follow Him.

By doing what the Lord commands,
we are obeying Him.

This is called an
act of obedience.

Then Jesus went from Galilee to the Jordan River to be baptized by John. But John tried to talk him out of it. "I am the one who needs to be baptized by you," he said, "so why are you coming to me?" But Jesus said, "It should be done, for we must carry out all that God requires." So, John agreed to baptize him.

Matthew 3:13-15

Where & how should we be Baptized?

At RockPointe Church, to make things easier for people, we use a hot tub or tank! In some cases, people will still go to a river or swimming pool.

In the Bible, people were baptized in rivers.

On the Sabbath, we went a little way outside the city to a riverbank, where we thought people would be meeting for prayer.

One of them was Lydia. As she listened to us, the Lord opened her heart, and she accepted what Paul was saying. She was baptized along with other members of her household.

Acts 16:13-15

As they rode along, they came to some water, and the eunuch said, "Look! There's some water! Why can't I be baptized?" He ordered the carriage to stop, and they went down into the water, and Philip baptized him.

Acts 8:36-39

For your baptism, you will be in a warm hot tub or tank with the person(s) you choose to baptize you. This person may be a pastor, someone special like a small group leader or even a parent!

When should we be baptized?

When you believe Jesus is Lord and pray to Him that you know He has saved you from your sins and you want Him to be the leader of your life.

If you are unsure if you are a Christian, talk to your parents or a leader at RockPointe. They would love to tell you how to do this.

YOU could pray a prayer something like the one below.

Dear Jesus,
Thank You for loving me enough to die on the cross for my sin. I know I do wrong things. Please forgive me for all the wrong things that I have done. I want You to come into my life. Help me to choose to do what You want me to do. I give my life to You and promise that I will follow and obey You. Thank you for making me Your child and a member of Your family. Amen.

How do you know for sure that Jesus is in your life? Check out the following verse: **But if we confess our sins to Him, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all wickedness.**

1 John 1:9

If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is by believing in your heart that you are made right with God and it is by confessing with your mouth that you are saved.

Romans 10: 9-10

- Wear dark colored clothing that you can change out of after. You will walk in bare feet to the Baptism tank.
- Bring a towel that you will carry up with you. Leave it beside the tank. Make sure you have a dry set of clothes to change into after.
- The water will be warm!
- The person baptizing you may say some things to you and ask you some questions.
- The person baptizing you will have you lean backwards into the water until your head is below the surface of the water.
- You will be under the water for only 1-2 seconds. You can even hold your nose!
- After you are standing, pause for a moment before leaving the tank so that you can enjoy the smile and blessing of God upon your life!
- Invite anyone and everyone to come to your Baptism!
- Encourage family to bring cameras and to take videos of you. Have them sit close to the front!
