Begin the chant with: The leader says.... "What Book are we studying?"

The kids shout "Exodus!, The story of God's people (slight pause) from captivity (show handcuffed hands) to (hand shading your eyes like you are searching)....... The Wilderness (arm extends out and then point sideways)

Moses starts the rhythm by tapping his staff on the floor. 1,2,3,4. 1,2,3,4. 1,2,3,4. Repeat three times then begin the chant.

- 1. Baby Moses (rock a baby in your arms), hidden on the Nile
 Pharoah's daughter adopts him with a smile (indicate a smile on your face with your fingers as you extend the corners of your mouth)
- God sent Moses (pretend to have a staff in your hand), to set His people Free (open your arms and raise them in the air)
 Jesus did that, for you (point to someone) and me (point to yourself).
- 3. Lived with the king (place a pretend crown on your head) in the palace grand
 But God raised him up (pretend to have a staff in your hand) for the Promised Land (point the pretend staff toward the Promised Land)
- 4. A burning bush (shade your face from the flames) to his surprise,
 God's voice came out (cup your hands and lower your voice) and made him wise (point to your head like you've got an idea)
- 5. **Moses said "Let My People Go"** (cupped hands at your mouth and shout this out) **But Pharoah said "No No No!"** (wag you finger and your head at the same time)
- 6. **10** (indicate the number 10 with your fingers) **Plagues in all, not just one** (wag one finger back and forth while wagging your head back and forth) **The final plague took the first born son** (indicate tears running down your cheeks)
- 7. **Released from bondage** (show handcuffed hands) **and finally free** (throw off your shackles), **Until they reached the Red Sea** (show face of fright with chattering teeth).
- 8. **"Oh no, what shall we do?"** (put your hand on the sides of your cheeks and exaggerate your fright), **Trust in God** (point to heaven), **cuz He loves you!** (give yourself a hug)
- 9. **God parts the sea** (indicate the water parting with your arms) **and they cross the same** day (bring your arms down and flow out Infront of you indicating the crossing of the river) **Too bad for Pharoah,** (put your hands on your hips in a sassy way), **he was washed away** (move your arms out from your waist out to your sides to show how they were all destroyed)

- 10. The people were hungry (hold your tummy) and grumbling again (make a grumpy face)

 God provided manna (twinkle your fingers like snowflakes falling down), on Him they depend (point to the sky)
- 11. **Up to the mountain** (make a mountain shape with your hands) **to meet with God** (spread your hands out above you)

Moses (pretend you have a staff) **went with an obedient nod** (nod your head one time)

- 12. "Holy Moses" What he saw! (Say this quicker and use your fingers to open your eyes up wide)

 Down he came with God's law (pretend to carry two tablets)
- 13. The people were tired of waiting (cross your arms and look impatient) and so
 They fashioned their own god out of gold. (make a fist and hammer into your other hand)
- 14. "Oh no, what shall we do?" (put your hand on the sides of your cheeks and exaggerate your fright), Trust in God (point to heaven), cuz He loves you! (give yourself a hug)
- 15. The tabernacle was built, and moved with carts (make a gesture like moving a wheelbarrow) If we trust in God, He dwells in our hearts (cover your heart with your hand)
- 16. God deserves our worship (praying hands), every day We are serving Him with what we do and say.
- 17. The people lacked faith to enter the land, (shake your head from side to side)
 Fear and fright were at hand
 Rebelled against God, so they did not go (thumbs down)
 An entire generation was told NO NO! (slowly pronounce the words NO and wag your finger and your head)
- 18. Sin has consequences as Moses found (strike the rock), he never saw that promised ground (sad face with fingers trailing tears down your cheeks)

 God sent Jesus to forgive us now, to trust in Him (praying hands), we must bow down (bow in prayer)
- 19. As our study comes to an end we see God's mercy (arms cross over your chest) once again
 Unfaithful people don't you know, come the snakes (emphasize the word snakes and gesture with
 your fingers to indicate snakes all over the ground) to add to their woe (frightened face)
- 20. God healed the people young and old, by looking to the serpent on the pole. (look up and point)

 Look to Jesus (point to your eye), make Him your own (arms crossed across your chest), to heal our
 hearts (make a heart with your fingers and bring it to your chest) and bring us home (point to Heaven).
