Narrator: Jennie and Joe were best friends. They were in class together and loved doing things together. There was just one big difference. Jennie was a Christian- she loved Jesus and loved learning about Him. Joe was not a Christian- his family didn't believe in Jesus.

Narrator: Jennie was always nervous to tell Joe about Jesus.

Joe: Oh I'm reading this really cool comic about Thor beating up bad guys- it's pretty awesome. He's my favorite superhero.

Jennie: That sounds cool!

Joe: Yeah- I guess he's like Jesus too, huh? I know that Jesus is supposed to be a god like Thor is. I bet there could be some cool comics where Jesus teams up with Thor to beat up Thanos or something. What sort of super powers does Jesus have?

Jennie: Well... He, um...

Joe: Thor has lightning powers. Maybe we can make up some powers for Jesus. Thor doesn't have fire powers, so let's say that Jesus has fire powers.

Jennie: Sorry Joe, I have to go. I think my mom is calling me.

Narrator: Jennie felt bad. She felt something in her telling her to tell Joe the truth about Jesus- but she was so nervous. How would she know what to say?
