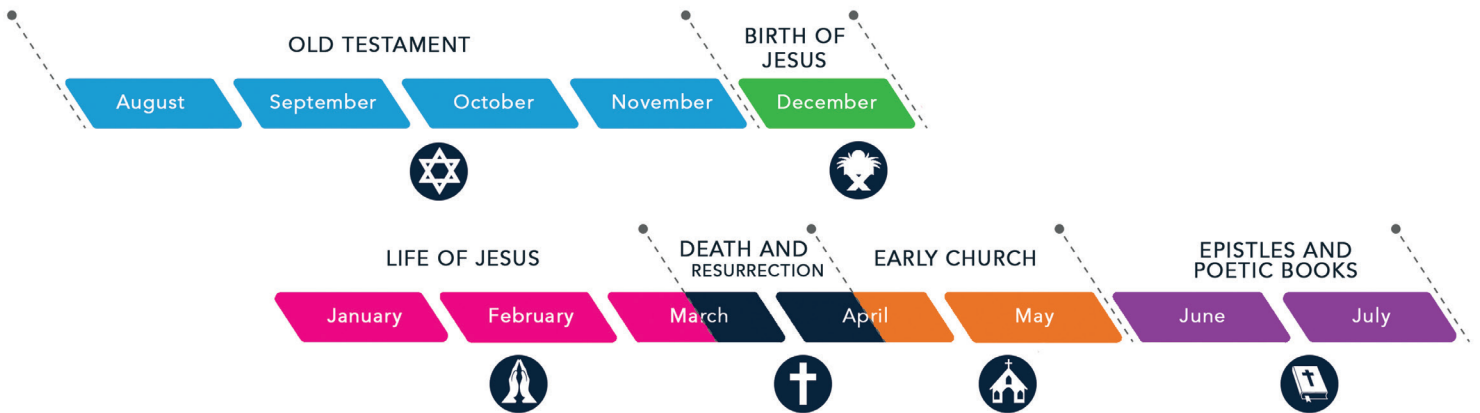
Elementary Scope and Sequence 2025-2026

About the GO! Elementary Scope and Sequence:

The GO! Scope and Sequence covers a total of 3 years. Each year begins in August and takes kids on a chronological journey through the entire Bible with different stories and with a different emphasis. During the 2025–2026 ministry year, kids will see and experience both God’s power and people through the Big Bible Story, but there will be a special emphasis on God’s promises. Throughout history, God has used covenants to define His relationship with man and to reveal His plan of

redemption through His son, Jesus. Kids will not only discover that God has always remained faithful to His covenants, but that His promise of eternal life extends to them as well. There will be glimpses of God’s salvation plan throughout the year, but there will be four lessons where that plan is communicated clearly and kids will have an opportunity to respond. Those lessons are denoted with *** next to the lesson title.

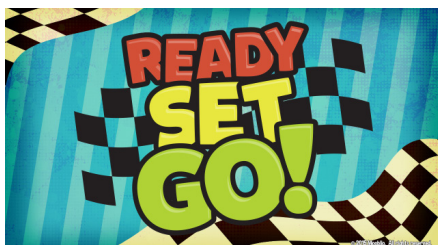

GET REEL: THE REEL CHRISTMAS STORY

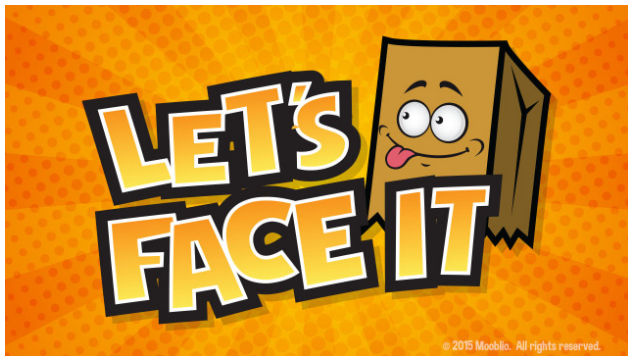
