## **Grades 2-5 Team**

## This Team's Role is to...

- **Connect** with kids by entering their world. Ask them about their passions. Many are involved in after school activities and are getting very good. Make sure to seek out those that are alone and help them connect with other kids in the group.
- **Correct** the children as they can quickly forget to follow the rules on listening, being nice, or being helpful. Kids this age are usually quick to apologize and forgive, but might need encouragement.
- **Care** for the children by listening to them. Ask them open-ended questions about what they are learning and then show them you care.

- **Correct** little ones as they move around the area and interact with other children. Keeping everyone safe and secure is our top priority.
- **Care** for the infants and toddlers. This is the main reason why people serve on this team. Spending time rocking a baby, reading to a toddler, or getting a little one to giggle will brighten your day.

# Age 2-4 Team



When you serve on the Age 2-4 team, you will be welcomed with open arms by some of the most énergetic and lovable kids in our church. This age loves to do things all by themselves. They are quick to involvé you in their imaginative play. Just ask them to cook you something and vou will soon have a block or toy tiger offered up on a plate. Pretend to eat it and you have just made a little friénd.

These children are learning all about their environment and how to interact with others. This team has the honor of modeling the Fruit of the Spirit (love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control) while helping them understand the difference between right and wrong. ## This Team's Role is to...

- Connect with parents as they drop off and pickup their children, but don't miss out on connecting with these lovable children. Get to know them and they will be asking for you by name.
- **Correct** the children as they move around the room; sometimes very fast. They may think they can do everything, but they will often need your help to keep them and others safe.
- Care for the children by sitting with them during the teaching time and then helping them create their crafts. Ask them lots of questions and you will discover just how much they are learning.

## This Team's Role is to...

- **Connect** with kids through play. You don't have to be as active as them, just join them in their activity or engage them with something interesting. Make sure to share something positive when their parents pick them up.
- **Correct** the children as active play can get out of hand for some. This group will also need friendly reminders to be good listeners during the teaching time.
- Care for the children by asking them lots of questions and reassuring them of God's great love for them. This age loves physical contact, so make sure to provide appropriate touch including side hugs.
