Position Title: Childcare Provider

Reporting Relationships

Position Reports to: Coordinator of Nursery/Childcare

Positions Supervised: Teen Childcare Providers and volunteer staff

Position Purpose

Childcare Providers provide care for Sunday worship, MOPS, Wednesday evening programming, Bible Studies, special service and any other care needs, as designated, to support the life of the church.

Essential Functions and Basic Duties*

- 1. Ensures that RCC Nursery/Childcare Ministry follows and adheres to all state and local laws and regulations pertaining to this type of ministry; Operates within the guidelines of the Safe Sanctuary Policy.
- 2. Train new staff/servant leaders.
- 3. Maintain open communications with staff/servant leaders, to include emails, team meetings and quick reporting of sick call/call offs.
- 4. Available for MOPS (Thursday mornings), Wednesday evenings and Sunday mornings, and other days as needs for care arise.
- 5. Requests cleaning/repair as needed.
- 6. Ensures that toys are cleaned regularly and in good working order.
- 7. Oversees the computer check-in system needs for Children's Ministries, on their shift.
- 8. All other duties, as assigned by the Coordinator of Nursery/Childcare or the Minister of Children
- 9. The Nursery/Childcare Ministry is a provider of safe and consistent care, that meets the needs of families while on site.
