### **Nursery Leader Role Description**

The Nursery Leader is responsible for caring & nurturing infants of Christ Community. Your ministry responsibilities include playing with, reading to & praying for each child while exhibiting Christ-like patience & care. Female volunteers age 16 years old & up will be responsible for diaper changing within the room. Leaders are also responsible for checking with the parents for any potential allergies & giving bottles if necessary. Our hallway has a 15 minute cry limit & leaders are responsible to inform the Hall Lead or Staff member so parents can be contacted. Creating & maintaining a clean environment is also essential by disinfecting toys and surfaces after each service is over.

### **Serving Expectations**

- Be in your serving position 20 minute prior to service start
- Every child’s diaper should be changed prior to pick up
- Ensure every parent has the proper security tag prior to picking up their child (If they do not, contact a hall lead or staff member to verify identification)
- Clean & disinfect toys/surfaces prior to ending your service shift

### **Interacting with Parents**

- Always thank the parent for bringing their child. It’s our privilege to serve them.
- Always smile (even when you’re tired)
- Always tell parents about diaper changes or feedings
- Always follow pick up procedures
